Raphael: [Hello everyone](#) , I'm Raphael .

Kirin: [Hello everyone](#) , I'm Kirin .

Adam: And hello, I'm Adam.

Kirin: [Welcome to Taiwan and our progressive course teaching Chinese](#) . What are we studying today ?

Raphael: Today we're going to teach you more ways to introduce yourself .

Kirin: [Wow, very interesting](#) . Ok, let's first listen to Raphael's self-introduction . In this introduction , Raphael is a foreigner . He is going to tell us why he is coming to Taiwan .

Raphael: [Hello, I'm Raphael](#) . I like Asian culture very much . So this time I'm very happy to be able to come to Taiwan . I heard there are many museums here that introduce Chinese culture , temples as well as historic sites . I also heard Taiwan has many delicious snacks . Finally, I hope I can make many new friends in Taiwan .

Kirin: [Ok, let's listen again to Raphael's self-introduction](#) . This time please repeat after me .

Kirin: [Hello, I'm Raphael](#) . I like Asian culture very much . So this time I'm very happy to be able to come to Taiwan . I heard there are many museums here that introduce Chinese culture , temples as well as historic sites . I also heard Taiwan has many delicious snacks . Finally, I hope I can make many new friends in Taiwan .

Kirin: [Next](#) , let's explain Raphael's self-introduction . Let's first look at what new words we have today .

Raphael: [First is "Asia"](#) .

Kirin: [Asia is a place](#) , but it's not a country . It's a continent . Do you remember what "zhōu" means ?

Raphael: [It's the "zhōu" in "Àozhōu" \(Australia\)](#) .

Adam: That you may remember means "continent."

Kirin: [There are seven continents](#) . Which continent is Taiwan in ?

Raphael: [Taiwan is in Asia](#) . So what do you think "Yàzhōu" means ?

Adam: It's, of course, "Asia."

Kirin: [Yes, so he likes Asian culture very much](#) . He then said that he is happy to be able to come to Taiwan . Do you remember what "kāixīn" means ?

Raphael: [It means happy](#) .

Kirin: [Yes](#) . He wants to go see many places . The first place is the museum .

Raphael: [What kind of museum is it](#) ?

Kirin: [It's a museum of Chinese culture](#) . As well, he wants to go to two other places . The first is a temple .

Adam: And that means "temple."

Kirin: [Temple](#) . The second place is a historic site .

Adam: And that means "historic site."

Kirin: [Historic site](#) . What else does he want to do in Taiwan ?

Raphael: Eat a lot of tasty snacks .

Kirin: What do you think “xiǎochī” means ?

Adam: That, literally, means “small eat” and is the word for “snack.”

Raphael: Snack .

Kirin: In the next sentence we saw a new word . Finally . “Zuì” and “hòu” , we have studied these two characters before . So what do you think “zuihòu” means then ?

Adam: The the most you may remember means “the most” while the end refers to “the end”; so together finally can mean “at the end,” “the last” or “finally.”

Adam: Snack.

Kirin: And the last one was “zuihòu” .

Adam: Finally.
